

Christmas Foot Prints

Merry Christmas! There's no better way to get into the Christmas spirit than with some Christmas-themed craft activities. These Christmas foot prints can be used to make some DIY Christmas cards, DIY wrapping paper or simply just a fun activity to keep the kids busy at home during the school holidays.

What you'll need:

- non-toxic paint (green, white, brown recommended)
- Baby wipes/ wash clothes to remove paint
- Paint brush
- Water bowl for washing pain brush
- Coloured markers (Red, black, gold/yellow, dark brown recommended)
- White or coloured card (For christmas cards)
- White or brown butchers paper (For wrapping paper)
- *(optional) buttons for the snowman, felt/material for the scarf, pompoms for the tree, stickers or glitter (for extra decoration!)*

What to do:

1. Make sure to do this outside or on a surface that can be cleaned easily if paint is spilled (not recommended on carpet).
2. Clean your kids feet before applying paint to ensure there are no dirt marks.
3. Use the pain brush to cover your kids feet in brown, white or green paint.
4. Get your child to stand on the piece or card/butchers paper to make a clean print.
 - if you are using the butchers paper, make mulitple foot prints of the same or different colours and evenly cover the entire paper to create a pattern.
5. Let the paint dry before adding the Christmas decorations to the foot prints.
